## Halcyon acquires project from Monarch

Tuesday, August 07, 2007

**HALCYON Group has added to its land holding in Western Australia's Goldfields region following the acquisition of the Goongarrie East project from Monarch Gold that is prospective for uranium and nickel.**

The company paid \$500,000 plus GST to Monarch and agreed to a 2% net smelter royalty on mineral production to acquire the 318 square kilometre project, adjacent to Halcyon's Lake Marmion uranium project.

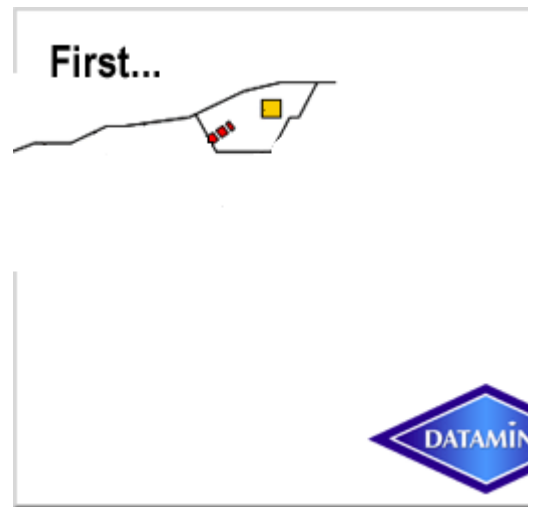
Halcyon managing director Iggy Tan said the project is 40km northwest and along strike of the Black Swan-Silver Swan nickel deposits that contain 170,000t nickel metal, and is 11km along strike of the Scotia East nickel deposit that has a resource of 86,000 tonnes at 2% nickel.

"The area is prospective for palaeochannel-sedimentary type uranium mineralisation and contains an interpreted extension of the ultramafic belt that hosts the Black Swan-Silver Swan nickel sulphide deposits," Tan said.

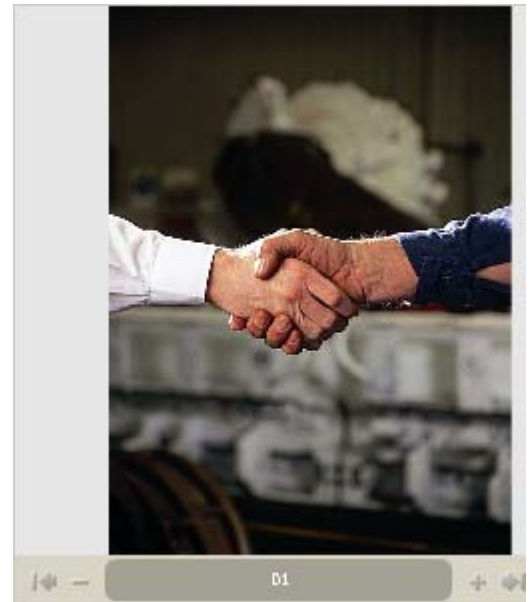
Halcyon said it has applied for the remaining 48sq.km of the Goongarrie East tenement.

Shares in Halcyon dropped 0.5c to 3.5c in trading this morning.
